HEAP COOLING ASSISTANCE

The HEAP Cooling Assistance Program provides for cooling assistance services to HEAP eligible households that include an individual with a documented medical condition that is exacerbated by the heat. Because the amount of funding is very limited, cooling assistance services will be provided on a first come, first serve basis. The HEAP Cooling Assistance Program is May 1, 2015 through August 31, 2015 or until the funds run out, whichever comes first.

Where to apply:

You may apply for the HEAP Cooling Assistance Program at your local Department of Social Services.

Your household may be eligible for HEAP Cooling Assistance Program Benefits if:

- You or your household members are United States Citizens of qualified aliens. AND
- Your household's gross monthly income is at or below the current income guides for your household size as posted in the table below OR
- You receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, formerly known as Food Stamps) benefits OR
- You receive Temporary Assistance OR
- You receive Code A Supplemental Security Income (SSI Living Alone)

Your household eligibility requirement include filing an application with your local Department of Social Services, providing all necessary documentation, and the household must reside in an eligible living situation.
